Letter	Meaning	Definition
NA	Not applicable	Doesn't apply to this job.
0	Occasional	The activity exists for up to 1/3 of the time when performing tasks within this role.
F	Frequent	The activity exists for between 1/3 and 2/3 of the time when performing tasks within this role.
С	Constant	The activity exists for more than 2/3 of the time when performing tasks within this role.
R	Repetitive	The activity involves repetitive movements.

	Physical demands of position tasks							
Kneeling and squatting	Tasks involve flexion or bending at the knees and ankle and possibly at the waist to work at low levels.							
Leg and foot movements	Tasks involve use of the leg or foot to operate machinery or equipment.							
Hand and arm movement	Tasks involve use of hands and arms (such as stacking, mopping, sweeping, sorting, inspecting, personal care).							
Bending and twisting	Tasks involve forward or backward bending or twisting at the waist.							
Standing	Tasks involve standing in an upright position without moving about.

Sitting	Tasks involve sedentary work that primarily involves sitting at a workstation.					
Driving	Tasks involve driving a vehicle for work purposes.					
Reaching	Tasks involve reaching overhead with arms raised above shoulder height or forward reaching with arms extended.

Walking	up steep slopes					
	while pushing or pulling or holding objects.					
Climbing	Tasks involve climbing up or down stairs, ladders, scaffolding, platforms, trees, play equipment, vehicles, etc.					
Working at heights	Tasks involve using ladders, foot stools, etc. (where the person stands on an object rather than the ground).					
	Tasks involve raising or lowering or moving objects from one level or position to another, usually holding the object in arms or hands.					
Lifting and carrying and	Light lifting/carrying/throwing (up to nine kgs)					
throwing	Moderate lifting/carrying/throwing (ten to 15 kgs)					
	Heavy lifting/carrying/throwing (16kgs and above).					
Pushing and pulling	Tasks involve pushing or pulling objects away from or towards the body. May include jerking movements.					
Grasping	Tasks involve gripping, holding, clasping with fingers or hands.					
Manual dexterity	Tasks involve fine finger movements (such as keyboard operations, handwriting, issuing medication).

Sensory demands of position's tasks								
Sight	Tasks involve the use of eyes (sight) as an integral part of task performance (such as looking at a screen, keyboard or mobile device, working in a dark environment, reading writing in documents).							
Hearing	Tasks involve being able to hear when working in a noisy area (such as a workshop, around equipment, many children)							
Smell	Tasks involve the use of smell as an integral part of the task performance (such as working with chemicals).							
Taste	Tasks involve the use of taste as an integral part of task performance.							
Touch	Tasks involve the use of touch as an integral part of task performance.							
	Psychological demands							
	Tasks involve interacting with distressed and emotional people.							
Interaction with people	Tasks involve interacting with people with mental illness, mental health issues or a disability.							
	Tasks involve witnessing or learning about disturbing or distressing personal circumstances and domestic violence.							
	Tasks require communicating with others (children or adults) to exchange information.							
	Tasks require giving direction and feedback on work undertaken by others.							
	Tasks require receiving direction and feedback on work undertaken to meet required work standards.							
Reasoning	Tasks require interpreting process documents, following plans and quality standards documentation.							
Responsibilities	Tasks involve being responsible for a group of children or vulnerable adults.

Working requirements	Tasks require work to be conducted out of hours (such as overnight).						
	Tasks are undertaken in a busy, demanding and dynamic work unit.						
	Tasks for the position require individual resilience and adaption to workplace change.

Liquids and powder	Tasks involve working with liquids and/or powders that may cause skin irritation if contact is made with skin.						
Sunlight	Tasks involve working outside with exposure to sunlight and require the application of sunscreen and insect repellent.						
Extreme temperature	Tasks involve working in temperature extremes (such as cool room, working outdoors, boiler rooms, kitchens).						
Biological hazards	Tasks involve working with biological products (such as blood, blood products or body fluids like urine, faeces or mucus).						
Lighting	Tasks involve working in lighting that is considered inadequate in relation to task performance (such as glare, not enough natural light).
